



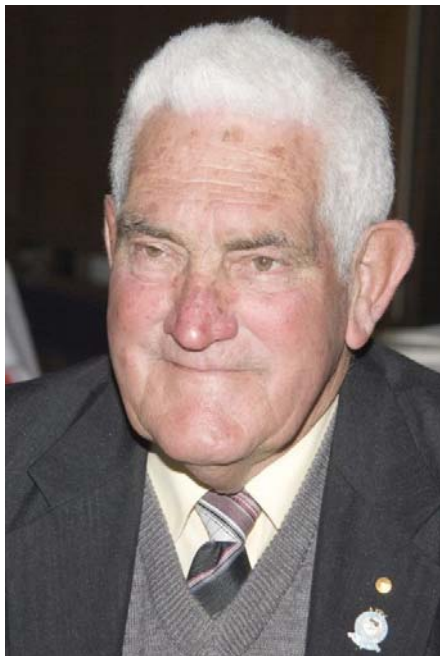

**Harold "HADJA" Palmer ( 21 June 1931 – 29 April 2008)**

This Club was saddened by the death of Harold 'Hadja' Palmer one of Port Kembla's great surf competitors. Hadja gained his Bronze Medallion on 8 February 1948. Hadja learned his swimming and surfing ability whilst his father was manager of the Port Kembla Olympic Pool.

He won both Surf and Belt races at Illawarra Branch Championships from 1954 to 1956 and following an outstanding performance at the State Championships at Freshwater in 1954, was selected to represent New South Wales in 1954, 1955 and at the Olympic surf carnival held in Torquay Victoria in 1956. He won the Australian Interstate Belt race in 1955.

Up until the time of his death Hadja could still be seen swimming in his favourite spot, the channel behind the Port pool.

## Boat Report

This year we had four crews on the water. Two U19's, One vets and the U23 women. The season started well with a 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> to the U19's, and a 1<sup>st</sup> to the U23 women in the Garie Dash at Bundeena. The crews competed through to the State Titles with the highlights being the U23 women missing a semi-final berth by one placing, and the U19 blacks making it to the fourth round. The vets also made it to the semi in the Masters Championships, finishing 4<sup>th</sup> in the semi. The two U19 crews competed in the ASRL Open at Broulee, with the U19 canaries reaching the quarter finals. In the South Coast Boat Series the crews rowed in all four rounds with the vets finishing best with a 3<sup>rd</sup> overall.

In the Branch Titles we picked up two bronze medals, the U19 canaries and the U23 women. The first surfboat medal for a Port Kembla women's boat crew.

The coming season we hope to have at least 5 crews training and competing, two U19's, U23 women, U23 men's and the vets/reserve crew.

I would like to thank Wollongong City S.L.S.C. for the kind donation of a second hand boat, which will be used for training purposes and to cut down on the wear of our two racing boats.

I hope all crews stick to their training, and don't take holidays mid season leaving their crewmates stranded, and all travel and compete at the Ausie Titles on the Gold Coast in 2010.
